## MARRIAGE LICENSES. 1841-1874

## INTRODUCTION

The 51st issue of the "GASPÉ OF YESTERDAY" series recalled the 1847 JOURNAL of the Rev.George Milne. Appointed by the Anglican Lord Bishop of Quebec to the Mission of Bay Chaleur in July,1841, the Rev.Milne then began a remarkable ministry extending over more than forty years and touching Gaspesians in communities from Gaspé Bay to Restigouche. From 1856 onwards the Rev.Milne had regional responsibility as the Rural Dean of the District of Gaspé. His memory is evoked by the granite tombstone to him and his wife, Isabella Smith Milne, that stands near the entrance to St.Andrew's Church, New Carlisle.

Throughout his long career in Gaspesia the Rev. Milne kept regular, meticulous records that are a treasure trove for the social historian. "GASPÉ OF YESTERDAY" appreciates the generosity of Eleanor Blois Hall of New Carlisle in making available not only such of Milne's JOURNALS that have survived but the following record of MARRIAGE LICENSES. 1841-1874.

Problems concerning marriage of the early settlers in Gaspesia have been recalled the 64th and 65th issues of "GASPÉ OF YESTERDAY" entitled, "WITH THIS RING I THEE WED" PARTS 1 and 2. Later in time, couples seeking to marry could proceed to obtain authorization through the reading of banns (notice of intended marriage, read three times in church, in order that any objection may be lodged) or, alternatively, apply to a duly authorized clergyman for a marriage license. In such case the signatures of two well-known citizens as bondsmen were required.

The following register of such marriage licenses issued by the Rev.George Milne over more than three decades is a unique and historic record of Gaspesian society. Not only does it serve to recall family and personal names of great interest but it adds details of residence, occupation and inter-community connections.
